The Read Aloud Tracker utilizes many features in Google Sheets to organize your daily reads:

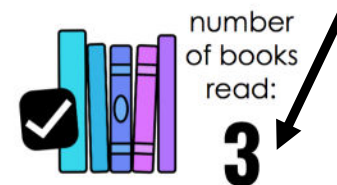
alphabetical menu to search by title



automatic counter to show total number of titles in your collection



automatic counter to track the number of books read
