

Colorful and Blackline Options

These colorful hundreds charts will help your students see number patterns with ease!

Each decade features a different bright shade to support young math students as they study numbers within 100.

This resource features two sizes to choose from:

- 8.25" x 8.25" (for a large visual)
- 4.1" x 4.1" (a smaller size for students to store in math toolkits or taped onto their desk/table)
